



Munson Township Park & Recreation Board Meeting

Wednesday, October 20, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m. by Tim Kearns.

Present: Kristen Bluemmel, John Kaczynski, Tim Kearns, Robert Marn, Barbara Parkinson, Michael Roche, Jonathan Schroeter. Absent: Joe Rosboril, Mark Stukbauer. Others in attendance: Andy Bushman, Irene McMullen.

Marn moved, seconded by Schroeter, to approve the minutes of the September 15, 2010 meeting. Approved unanimously.

Breakfast with Santa

Parkinson moved, seconded by Schroeter, to request \$750 from the Munson Township Trustees for the event. Passed unanimously.

Park Updates

Scenic River Retreat - the electric lines need to be laid out. An estimate of \$1169 was received for a 35-foot pole, installed. More research needs to be done. A Boy Scout Eagle project has started on the trails. A rubbish can is needed at the lower pavilion until the gate at the top is chained.

Nero Nature Preserve - the stairs were completed for a Boy Scout Eagle project. Bluemmel and son Ryan, Marn, and Stukbauer worked on the trails; it was noted that the road crew will need to pull downed trees across the trail; Jim Teichman will be contacted directly. A bridge and benches need repair. Bluemmel wants an event at this park; a hayride event with cider and donuts and bonfire will be explored.

Munson Township Park - Rosboril sent a report that the kiosk is finished. The tennis courts have had the cracks sealed; one more has to be redone.

Events Subcommittee

Three Munson Township women are interested in this subcommittee. Kearns will present the idea to the Prosecutor re legality, liability issues, etc. If OKd they will be invited to a future Park Board meeting for a group interview.

Flea Market

Schroeter presented a financial report. The event was a great success. Traffic was steady from beginning to end; it is estimated that 500 cars came to the event; more help parking is needed. Concerns were expressed about signage

Other

Bluemmel asked about the possibility of selective harvesting of the trees at Nero Nature Preserve. Kearns will verify if the easement permits this activity.
