The meeting was called to order at 6:32pm by Chairman Todd Ray with Trustees Andy Bushman and Irene McMullen and Fiscal Officer Judy Toth present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited at the Audit Committee meeting, which preceded the Trustees meeting. Let the record reflect, at the November 27th meeting the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Scout Brian Depner of Boy Scout Troop 2261. Warrants 10911-10930 dated 12/7/12 totaling \$32,728.48 and EFT Vouchers 2229-2237 for the 12/07/12 bi-weekly payroll totaling \$9,443.00 were signed between meetings. Warrants 10931-10944 dated 12/11/12 totaling \$9,292.54 were signed. Correspondence and the Fiscal Officer's monthly report for November were available.

MINUTES

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the November 13, 2012 minutes as written, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the minutes of November 27, 2012 as written, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

CEMETERY DEED

The Trustees signed a deed to Richard C. and Billie J. Erickson for Fowlers Mill II Cemetery, Lot 347, Graves 10, 11, and 12.

MONTHLY FISCAL REPORT

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the Fiscal Officer's monthly report for November 2012, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Ray asked for public comment. There was none.

PARK REPORT

Park Board members Joe Rosboril, Bob Marn, John Kaczynski, and Jon Schroeter were present. Joe Rosboril reported that the Breakfast with Santa was a success and submitted his expense report. All of the supplies were used up this year due to the large number of volunteers. The event made a profit of approximately \$450. He asked the Board to make a donation to Boy Scout Troop 91 as the parents, leaders, and scouts provided the volunteer labor for setup, cooking, serving, and cleanup. Mr. Rosboril requested \$350 for advertising expenses to hold an indoor flea market on Saturday, February 16 from 9am-2pm.

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to encumber \$350 to cover advertising and expenses for an indoor flea market Saturday, February 16, 2012 from 9am-2pm, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. The expense will be encumbered in January.

TOWNSHIP HALL PROJECT

Architect Hank Penttila submitted the building plans to the county engineer. The construction documents are complete and he is making a final review of the bidding documents. A photometric survey of the site was completed and will utilize luminaires to light the parking lot and drives. Mr. Penttila submitted a drawing of the proposed locations and the extent of the lumination. He recommended that the Board use a proven lighting product, and suggested metal halide lights, to be located approximately 20 feet off the ground. The poles can be made of aluminum, fiberglass, or steel. Seven poles will be required to illuminate the roadway and parking areas, at a cost of \$2600-\$3000 per pole for the pole, base, and wiring. The lighting will be directed and will meet OSHA requirements for safety. He reviewed the four alternate bid items, substitute VCT in place of ceramic tile in the restrooms with 4" vinyl base and painted walls, substitute VCT and 4" vinyl wall base in place of carpet in community room, standing seam metal roof in place of fiberglass-asphalt shingles, and waterproof roofing application at scupper locations at common wall between Fire Station and existing Town Hall in place of fiberglass-asphalt shingles. The Trustees noted that if the metal roof option is selected, a portion of the existing roof would not be metal. The architect will add the roof over the fire station offices as an add alternate, with the cost of the additional section split out. Mr. Penttila advised that the existing hallway will be painted as part of the contract, and suggested replacing the ceiling pads, grids and lights as an add-alternate. Mr. Penttila met with assistant prosecutor Rebecca Schlag to review the alternate bidding methods that are available due to the reform of the Ohio Construction Laws. Little construction has taken place in Ohio since the law passed, and the prosecutor's office has no experience. This would be a learning process for the prosecutor's office as well. Mr. Penttila saw benefits to the township's use of a Construction Manager at Risk and will meet again with Ms. Schlag., The Township can follow that route if the Prosecutor's office is willing to guide it through the process. Otherwise, it will be necessary to follow the regular bidding process. The architect left a set of plans for the Trustees to review. He offered to provide additional sets if needed.

RESOLUTION 2012-55/JON SCHROETER RETIREMENT

Resolution 2012-55 was made by Irene McMullen and seconded by Andy Bushman to acknowledge the retirement of Park and Recreation Board member Jon Schroeter, who served on the park board for sixteen years from its inception on December 16, 1995 to December 31, 2012, and to express the township's appreciation for his contributions, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. [The resolution in its entirety is included on a separate page as part of the minutes.] The meeting recessed at 7:05pm for refreshments and reconvened at 7:30pm.

ROAD REPORT

Road Superintendent Jim Teichman contacted Ed Schmidt GMC, the low bidder for the 2013 truck. They agreed to deliver the truck at no additional cost to the township.

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to award the bid for the 2013 pickup truck to Ed Schmidt GMC not to exceed \$32,925.50, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. Mr. Teichman advised that the successful bidder for the township's 1988 International Dump Truck would like the township to accept a lower bid. For the record, upon the advice of the Prosecutor's office, the bidder was informed that the township cannot take less than the bid offer, and the bid was withdrawn. Mr. Teichman will keep the truck until spring. The Trustees asked the road superintendent if he had received complaints about the missing street light at the corner of Auburn and Sherman Road. Mr. Teichman was advised by FirstEnergy that they are realigning the poles from the intersection to the Preston property. After the poles have been realigned, the pole at the intersection will be set. All of Munson Township's signs have been accepted for replacement with high visibility signs through a grant, except for those which have already been replaced. The signs will be placed at the proper height and location and a list of the signs and locations will be given both to the county engineer and to the township.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Department Chief Mark Lynn reported that the township will receive cost estimates for the approved Opticom locations in January. He was pleased to report that the state is extending its 2012 grants to 2013. The equipment grant is the most critical to the Munson Fire Department. He discussed a five year "safer" grant used to transition a fire department into absorbing the cost for additional personnel.

KLINGMANN DEMOLITION

Zoning Inspector Tim Kearns reported on the progress of the Klingmann demolition. It appears that the property will be eligible for the Moving Ohio Forward Grant. He requested \$75 for Geauga Title for a lien search. The Ohio EPA will not require additional asbestos testing and will accept HzW's reports. Pictures must be taken before and during the project. He will prepare the contractors' request for proposal form for the Trustees to review. The prosecutor's office recommended that the township restart the process from the beginning.

<u>RESOLUTION 2012-56 – FUND CERTIFICATION, TRANSFER, AND APPROPRIATION</u> REDUCTION

Resolution 2012-56 was made by Andy Bushman and seconded by Irene McMullen to request the Budget Commission to reduce the appropriations in the General Fund and Road and Bridge Fund, to certify additional revenues in the NOPEC Grant Fund, and for within fund transfers in the General, Cemetery, Road and Bridge, Zoning, and Fire Operating and Apparatus Funds, in the Permanent Appropriation, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. [The resolution in its entirety is included on a separate page as part of the minutes.]

RESOLUTION 2012-57 – AMENDED AMOUNTS AND RATES

Resolution 2012-57 was made by Irene McMullen and seconded by Andy Bushman to accept the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission, authorizing the necessary tax levies, and certifying them to the County Auditor, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. [The resolution in its entirety is included on a separate page as part of the minutes.]

RESOLUTION 2012-58 – 2013 TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION

The Board amended the draft of the Temporary Appropriation to include funds for the February flea market and demolition of the Klingmann property at 13417 Rockhaven Road.

Resolution 2012-58 was made by Andy Bushman and seconded by Irene McMullen to approve the Munson Township Temporary Appropriations through March 31, 2013 in the amount of \$2,813,037.12, with a unanimous vote. LIQUOR LICENSE HEARING

The Board addressed a notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control regarding a change of ownership for the liquor license for Sand Ridge Golf Club.

Andy Bushman moved and Todd Ray seconded to waive the right to a public hearing for a liquor license for Sand Ridge Golf Club. Roll call vote: Mr. Bushman, yes; Mr. Ray, yes; Mrs.

McMullen, abstain. Mrs. McMullen abstained to avoid a potential conflict of interest as she is a member of one of the golf club's environmental boards.

CLEANING CONTRACT

The Board will table approval of a cleaning contract for the township hall. The proposed contract is for one year and does not address the building renovation.

HORVATH BZA RESIGNATION

Board of Zoning Appeals member Sophie Horvath informed the township office that she is resigning from her position and will not be able to attend the December hearing.

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to accept the resignation of Sophie Horvath from the Munson Township Board of Zoning Appeals with regret, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

OIL AND GAS SEMINAR

Irene McMullen reported on the progress of the Oil and Gas Seminar. The seminar will be held January 17 at 7pm at the Notre Dame Educational Center auditorium. It will be co-sponsored by the Geauga County Commissioners, and the moderator will be Judge Forrest Burt. Senator John Eklund has agreed to attend. The purpose of the seminar will be to provide information to the public.

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to co-host the seminar on oil and gas on January 17, 2013 at 7pm at the Notre Dame Educational Center, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

TRUSTEE COMPENSATION

Mr. Ray moved and Mr. Bushman seconded that for 2013, the Trustees will be compensated by the salary method and receive the maximum amount allowable by the Ohio Revised Code, equal to the maximum amount that could be received annually by a Trustee if he or she were to be paid on a per diem basis, and payable in twelve equal monthly payments, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

ELECTED OFFICIALS INSURANCE

Mr. Ray moved and Mr. Bushman seconded to offer health insurance, dental insurance, and the highest amount available of life insurance under the township life insurance policy up to \$50,000 to a newly elected or appointed Township Trustee or Fiscal Officer, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to hold an organizational meeting on Tuesday, January 8, 2013 at 6:30pm, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

COMMUNITY ROOM RENTAL

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to lease the community room for a music party (Kouwe) on December 21, 2012 from 6-10pm, approx. 76, to waive the \$75 room fee, and to require the \$50 security deposit, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to lease the community room for a family Christmas gathering (Eisler) on December 24, 2012 from 9pm to midnight, approx.50, for a \$75 room fee and \$50 security deposit, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.




